It is our aim that Mole Valley Green Burial Ground remains a natural and unspoilt environment, which provides an organic habitat for a variety of wild grasses, wild flowers, insects, birds and other wildlife. A tree can be planted by the grave as a memorial and the area will ultimately evolve into mature woodland. With all this in mind the following Terms and Conditions will apply:

- Only biodegradable, environmentally friendly coffins are to be used. No chipboard, metal or plastic
- No borders or mowing of any kind around graves
- No coloured stone chips, man-made items such as windmills, windchimes, artificial flowers, ornaments or vases of any kind may be placed on or around the grave
- Only native wild flowers and traditional trees may be planted
- Non-biodegradable tributes will be removed not less than 14 days after internment
- No seats or benches are permitted
- > Trees will be planted in the planting season i.e. between October and March
